



Information for Pre-Nursing Students 2016-2018

Minimum Academic Requirements for Entrance into the Nursing Program (subject to change)

- Students must pass (or have in progress) all **eight prerequisite courses** (see below) with a minimum **3.25 GPA**.
- Students must have a minimum **3.25 cumulative GPA**.
- The minimum passing grade in Human Anatomy and Physiology is a 'B'.
- Students cannot repeat previously **passed** prerequisite courses in order to raise their GPA (this parallels University policy). Exception: repeated courses that were initially taken more than five years ago.
- Students who do not pass **more than one class** required for the nursing major (i.e., prerequisite, co-requisite, or Nursing) are disqualified from being in the nursing program.
- Freshmen who satisfactorily complete all prerequisite courses by the end of the spring semester of their freshmen year will receive priority placement into a fall nursing program entering cohort. Students who complete prerequisites during the summer will be placed into fall nursing courses on a space available basis.
- Initial eligibility for freshmen to be admitted into the program (Sophomore1) will be determined after their first semester's prerequisite grades.
- Before entering the Nursing program, all students must be medically cleared in order to ensure the safety and well-being of patients encountered in the clinical setting.

*CHEM 1600	Health Science Chemistry + lab (Organic)
*BIO 2500	Human Anatomy + lab (min. grade = 'B')
*BIO 2600	Human Physiology + lab (min. grade = 'B')

* If Health Science Chemistry or Microbiology is **not passed the first time it is taken**, a minimum grade of 'B-' is required to pass when the course is repeated and it may only be repeated once. Human Anatomy and Physiology must be passed with a 'B'.

PROGRAM PLAN FOR COMPLETION OF BSN REQUIREMENTS

- Based on placement exam results, additional coursework in English (e.g., ENGL 1003), math (e.g., MATH 1100, 1210, or 1300), or chemistry (e.g., CHEM 1500/05) may be required.
- Transfer students follow a somewhat different program plan for General Education (see transfer course evaluation).
- Honors students take FYE 2000 and NURS 4998.
- Minimum grade in prerequisite and co-requisite classes is a C with the exception of Human Anatomy and Physiology (min. grade is a B). Minimum grade in NURS/NURL is a C+. Students who do not pass **more than one class** required for the nursing major (i.e., prerequisite, co-requisite, or Nursing) are disqualified from the nursing program.
- The four year guarantee does not apply to nursing majors.

Transfer Honor Society Award	\$2,500 for Alpha Gamma Sigma or Phi Theta Kappa honor societies.
Bay Area Transfer Grant <i>*Non-nursing students only</i>	\$2,000 for students transferring from College of Marin, Diablo Valley College, Napa Valley College, Santa Rosa Junior College, and Solano Community College.
Coaches Award	Awarded to selected athletes based on NCAA Division II regulations.
Dominican Grant	Amount varies depending on financial need and academic performance. Up to \$10,000
California State Cal Grants A&B	\$9,084 tuition award for qualifying California residents through June 30, 2018.
Federal Pell Grant	Up to \$5,920 for students with significant financial need through June 30, 2018.
Federal SEOG Grant	Up to \$2,000 for students with significant financial need who qualify for Pell Grants.
