**GENERAL EDUCATION:** Requires completion of a minimum of 19 units, distributed in the above areas, with an **overall grade point average of 2.0** ("C"). While a course may satisfy more than one G.E. Area, it may not be counted in more than one Area (except in Area 5, *Ethnic Studies*; see Note above).

**MAJOR:** Students must declare a major to earn an Associate Degree. Majors require a minimum of 18 units, with a **grade of "C" or better in each course.** Unit requirements for majors vary within Programs and Instructional Departments of the College (*consult the Merritt College Catalog and/or see a Courselor for more information*).

**OUT-OF-DISTRICT OR OUT-OF-STATE COURSES:** Will be evaluated individually to see if they fulfill Merritt College General Education requirements. For information about this process, students should contact the Counseling Department. **6/00**
