One third of student's tuition will be paid for if they have a 3.0 or above through Merit Scholarships.  April will provide a fee waiver code to any counselor. Just ask her. Mills offers a 2+2 transfer pathway for Merritt students in which students can complete their BA and the requirements for a teaching credential in four years. There is also the option to earn a bilingual credential. Mills has an ADT Commitment in which students with ADT's in one of their majors is guaranteed admission to Mills at junior standing.  Cross Registration is available if a Merritt student wants to take a class at Mills but not pay additional fees. Mills has an accelerated degree program in which students can earn a Bachelors and Masters in three years (if they come in with 60 units).
