Counselor Meeting Minutes March 28, 2005

Meeting convened at 1:40 p.m. In attendance: Zielke, Wong, Shriver, Blackwell, Allen, Scurry, DeCoursey, Pantell, Crutchfield, Cannady, White, Oliveira, MacEwan (intern). Guest: Ann Elliott and Jon Drinnon from English Department.

1. <u>English Department Dialogue</u> Elliott and Drinnon addressed the following points:

 \cdot When reviewing assessment scores, reading and writing carry equal weight when considering classes. If one or the other is low, not likely to be successful in ENGL 1A.

• If scores borderline, not a good idea to suggest higher level course.

• When in doubt, suggest more preparation for 1A (by recommending the 201A-B sequence).

When using multiple measures, focus on time commitment needed for success (i.e. 2:1 ratio of outside class to in-class hours). How long since last English class and grade/level of success may not be best criteria for success.
ENGL 252 A-B sequence recommended for students w/ very low reading and mid-level writing. ENGL Dept. considering whether to offer 252 as a combined course (similar to 201A-B).

• All sections of 201A-B are combined courses, not just those for Puente students.

• Area of confusion: if student does very well in 201A, instructor can either recommend they go into either 201B or 1A. Counselors don't know which course instructor recommending. Suggested having ENGL instructors complete half-sheet for students to bring to counseling appts. when planning next semester.
