The College of Alameda's General Education transfer pattern is designed to meet the CSU transfer requirements. As a transfer student you should: (1) Meet with a COA counselor to create a Student ED Plan that will assist you in identifying the transfer major and general education requirements successfully; (2) Request the CSU-GE Certification when you request final transcripts to be sent to your choice of university or college; and (3) With a counselor's assistance, determine whether you are eligible for an associate degree.

Notes: There is an additional 9 semester/12 quarter upper division GE units required to graduate from the transfer CSU campus. Community College students are limited to a maximum of 70 semester/105 quarter transferable units to the CSU system. Area A1, A2, A3, and B4 must be completed with a grade "C" or better.

AREA A: COMMUNICATION IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE & CRITICAL THINKING

Minimum 9 semester (or 12-15 quarter) units: Complete minimum one course from each sub area with a grade of "C" or better.

- A1: Oral Communication Comm 1A, 1B, 4, 20, 45
 A2: Written Communication Engl 1A
 A3: Critical Thinking Comm 5, Engl 5, Phil 10

For A3, some engineering majors exceptions may apply (see a counselor for details).

AREA B: PHYSICAL UNIVERSE & ITS LIFE FORMS

Minimum 9 semester (or 12-15 quarter) units; one from Physical Sciences (B1), one from Life Sciences (B2), and one from Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning (B4). One lab* activity required from either Physical Sciences or Life Sciences or (B3). Math/Quantitative Reasoning (B4) with a grade "C" or better.

 Geog 1; Geol 10; Phys 4A*, 4B*, 4C*, 10
 B2: Life Sciences Anthr 1; Biol 1A*, 1B*, 10*, 11, 12A*, 12B*, 14*, 26*
 B3: Lab Activity - one course from either B1 or B2 with a lab* or
 one of the following: Anthr 1L or Geog 1L
 B4: Math/Quantitative Reasoning: 2, 3ABCEF, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16AB, 50

AREA C: ARTS, LITERATURE, PHILOSOPHY & FOREIGN LANGUAGE

Minimum 9 semester (or 12-15 quarter) units, with at least one course each in Arts and Humanities.

*Students taking Thart 1 for 2 units will need an additional unit (or course) to clear this area.

Minimum 9 semester (or 12-15 quarter) units with courses in at least two different disciplines.
