Eight of the ten general education requirements at Mills College can be met in a number of ways, including transfer credit or relevant AP courses. For transfer purposes, one course may satisfy up to two general education requirements.

Interdisciplinary Perspectives	Students entering before the Junior year must take Mills COLL 060. Sophomore transfer students who have completed the equivalent of 12.75 Mills' credits will be exempt from this requirement, with the recommendation to take a Mills interdisciplinary course if there is none shown on the transcript..
