

PATTEN UNIVERSITY and MERRITT COLLEGE Transfer Partnership

Patten University will consider up to 61 semester units for transfer credit. These units will be accepted and applied to a Patten University bachelor's degree program when students meet specific criteria. These are as follows:

- 1. All previous academic college coursework reflects a minimum 2.0 grade point average.
- 2. All courses transferred and applied to a Patten University bachelor's degree program reflect a grade "C" or higher.
- 3. Students who are transferring from a two- or four-year college, there is no SAT/ACT requirement.
- 4. In lieu of Patten University General Education core requirement, students may transfer up to 52 semester units of acceptable (certified) general education program credits which reflect one of the following:
 - a. California State University General Education Breadth Requirements
 - b. Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC UC or CSU)
 - c. In addition to up to 52 semester units in general education transfer courses, students may transfer up to 9 lower division semester units (unrestricted) applied to the bachelor's degree.
