





PATTEN UNIVERSITY and MERRITT COLLEGE
Transfer Partnership

Patten University will consider up to 61 semester units for transfer credit. These units will be accepted and applied to a Patten University bachelor's degree program when students meet specific criteria. These are as follows:

1. All previous academic college coursework reflects a minimum 2.0 grade point average.
2. All courses transferred and applied to a Patten University bachelor's degree program reflect a grade "C" or higher.
3. Students who are transferring from a two- or four-year college, there is no SAT/ACT requirement.
4. In lieu of Patten University General Education core requirement, students may transfer up to 52 semester units of acceptable (certified) general education program credits which reflect one of the following:
 - a. California State University General Education Breadth Requirements
 - b. Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC - UC or CSU)
 - c. In addition to up to 52 semester units in general education transfer courses, students may transfer up to 9 lower division semester units (unrestricted) applied to the bachelor's degree.
