Articulation Notes
May 10, 2004

- 1. Business Administration at SFSU** SFSU's College of Business will be initiating a minimum grade policy affecting core business major requirements effective fall 2004. Students must earn a grade of C- or better in core business courses being used as prerequisites for other core business courses. Students who received grades D-, D, or D+ before Fall 2004 will be given an exception to this rule for any such courses. Courses requiring a C- or better include: SPCH 150 (CSU GE (A--1), ENG 214 (CAN ENGL 4), DS/MATH 110, ISYS 263, ECON 100, ECON 101, ACCT 100, ACCT 101, DS 212, FIN 350, BUS 360, ISYS 363, MGMT 405, DS 412, MKTG 431, BUS 682. - 2. Laney Changes General Curriculum Major** The following resolution from the Laney College Counseling Department was approved at the 5/3/04 CIPD meeting: *Whereas the terminology of "General Curriculum" does not clearly define, describe or address specifically a major; therefore, be it resolved, that the new terminology for General Curriculum should be changed to Associate in Arts Degree in Liberal Arts at Laney College."*
- 3. SPCH 46 Change** Effective F04, SPCH 46 will change from a single, 3-unit course to three 1-unit modules (SPCH 46A, 46B, & 46C). I've gotten approval from the CSU GE review board for the course to remain on our CSU GE Area A1 list (Oral Communication), with the following footnote: "Acceptable for CSU GE Area A1 only if SPCH 46A, SPCH 46B, & SPCH 46C completed." This will be noted on the 04-05 CSU GE advising sheet.
- 4. Heald Articulation Guide** The District articulation officers, in consultation with the District English faculty, have developed an articulation guide for Heald College. The guide lists Heald courses that will be acceptable for use to clear General Education requirements for AA/AS, CSU GE, and IGETC Areas. I will create a Heald page and post the guide on the Counselor web site as soon as I possibly can. In the meantime, I'll put a copy of the guide in counselor boxes and have additional copies available in my office.
