Counselor Meeting Minutes February 11, 2013

Meeting convened at 1:30 p.m. In attendance: McLean, Scurry, Zielke, Khoo, Pantell, and Ilarde. Guest: Mary Louise Zernike, Nutrition and Dietetics

- 1. <u>NUTR Programs</u> Zernike gave overview of two programs (Merritt only CCC that offers both):
 - · Dietary Tech (DT): 5 core NUTR courses + 150 hours of internship (NUTR 7lA); trains students to run food service operation (after passing CDM license exam); starting salaries ~\$18-\$22/hr
 - · Dietary Manager (DM): 5 core courses + 450 hours internship (NUTR 71A-C); trains students to run a dietary operation; starting salaries
 - ·`\$22-\$25/hr
 - ·Both programs impacted—admit students on following priority basis (w/ Merritt students having top priority:
 - · Completion of all prereq courses (DM= clinical courses; DT = clinical + GE)
 - · Veterans
 - · Previous work in NUTR facility and need degree/cert to maintain employment
 - · After students above, then got to Group B (i.e. students who don't have any or all above + highest GPA)
 - · Must apply to both programs; application period starts toward end of each semester (fall = last Monday in October; spring = last Monday in April)—orientation first (in NUTR 70A) followed by 2 weeks to complete & submit app; usually admit -14 students but have taken up to 16
 - · Strong requirement of success in both programs is ability to do basic math (calculations/percents/budgets, etc.)
 - · Check website for current information
