	<p>Sociology <i>Remember when doing a degree evaluation or petition for Sociology that List B notes students are able to use “any course not already used above” not just the courses in List B.</i></p>	
	<p>Guests: Admissions & Records -Late add process <i>For short term classes, students must add within the first week. They must also drop on the first day or they will be charged for the class.</i> -Summer graduate list <i>Addresses are needed so graduation information can be mailed and so the graduation photographer will have their addresses. Also needed is how the student wants their name printed on the degree (i.e. middle initial, middle name or no middle name). They cannot use a name that is not on record, unless they complete a name change request.</i> -Degrees and certificates <i>These can be picked up in August for Spring graduates. If students need a status letter for a job, A&R can provide this.</i> <i>Degrees and certificates are kept for one year then they are sent to the district.</i> -Change of major <i>If a student’s major is changed, send them to admissions and they will be able to determine if the date of the major change needs to be back dated for financial aid purposes. This is only for students who receive financial aid.</i> -Deadlines <i>The deadline for Spring petitions is March 16th and there will be no extensions. Students who miss this deadline will have to petition in the summer.</i> <i>The deadline for students to be added to the commencement participation grad list on the counselor website who need six units or less in the summer is March 23rd.</i></p>	<p>De La Torre/ Roque/Rivera- Cordova</p>
