Not able to determine ifa manual exists.</li> <li>Even minimum requirements for Student Academic Progress (SAP) are missing at this campus.</li> <li>Need to form a SAP committee from all areas of the college</li> <li>Appeals for 150% attempted hours rule: depending on your Campus SAP policy you may approve or deny</li> <li>Extenuating circumstances means: it's outside of the student's control.</li> <li>Stats: the institution needs to keep track of how many appeals are received per year and how many of those approved do graduate.</li> <li>There are audit findings that were found before. The campus needs to follow the corrective action they agreed to. That has not been the case.</li> <li>Clary and drug/alcohol policies need to be reviewed and updated. There is no process for late start classes.</li> <li>Staff training: staff needs to be allowed to attend trainings.
