	Standing Items: 1. Reports from programs: Puente, Sankofa, FYE, Veterans, SAS, EOPS, Transfer Center, Centro Latino, etc.  Puente: Currently doing outreach for the fall. Students must not have completed Engl 1A and must be committed to Puente. Jose will create a flyer. Please refer students to Jose.  SAS: Mary will email flyers of the basic skills classes (English, math and a career class). Completing all three will earn students either a credit or noncredit certificate. The English and math courses are at a six grade level. They are open to all students. Students with very low math and English abilities will benefit as well as students who have had IEPs or special education in high school. Students who just are not ready for transfer level English and math and need a confidence booster might select these courses.  Adelante Summer Bridge: Currently recruiting for summer session. Students who want to take an English course before transfer level English in the fall would be good candidates for this program. They will have one on one meetings with the instructors via zoom. This is a great option for students who want to brush up or polish their English skills. Please refer interested students to either Marissa, Mayra, or Rosa.  Transfer: CSUEB classes will be online in the fall. P (Pass) is an acceptable grade for Spring 2020 including in the golden 4 and major prep courses. They will accept 48 units and above completed for fall 2020 transfer, however they recommend students with less than 60 take summer courses.  The SIR (student intent to register) deadline is 6/1/20.
