	-General notes about SFSU:	
	- Completing the minimum requirements will get you	
	accepted into all majors except those that are	
	impacted.	
	- The most common application error is students	
	marking "30-60 units will be completed" instead of	
	60-90 units. They will be denied since they are	
	considered lower division transfers.	
	- If students tell us they had to list all of their high	
	school and SAT info, that means they entered their	
	information wrong and must go under extended	
	profile to correct it.	
	- Vets can apply at any time with any number of units	
	but it's better for them to transfer at the junior level.	
	- When applying for an impacted major, the student's	
	second choice must be a non-impacted one.
