Each meeting is private. -Once a student "knocks on the door" they get an agreement statement then they log in. -The counselor can determine if they want to chat. Or they can send the student to another moderator (i.e. financial aid). -The counselor or moderator can put the student in a virtual waiting lobby and another person can pick them up. There can be a customized message or video in the lobby. We can see how long and where students are in the queue. We can send a group lobby message. -Students can schedule a meeting. Open availability will show up. We can determine how far in advance students can book appointments. Students will see what counselors are available. Students can receive two text message reminders. -There is a customizable intake form. -We can pull reports based on our intake form. -Video sessions can be recorded or can be set to NOT record. We can stop or start recording. Recordings are archived. -Commonly used forms can be uploaded. Forms can be highlighted, typed on and capture signatures. There is a "pencil tool" for this. -We can give students assignments. -There is a whiteboard which can be typed on or use the pencil. There is also an edit pad and google doc features. -There are keyboard shortcuts for those without a mouse. -There is live closed captioning. A dedicated headset with a microphone is recommended.
