1:30-2:00	Zoom Demo and Follow Up Discussion for online counseling -There is an option to choose a virtual background. -Can assign closed captioning -Can remove a disruptive person -There is a polling feature -You can share and use a virtual whiteboard. -Students can use an iphone, ipad, or android but will have to download a free app first otherwise they will only have audio and not visual. If they are using a laptop or desktop you do not have to download an app. -The host can play a video and talk over the video. -If we need HIPA compliance, we will lose some of the features. For example we could not transfer files or do screenshots or cloud recording. -They are FERPA compliant. -Can record onto the cloud or desktop (MP4 file) but can not edit. Participants cannot record. -The host has three options regarding closed captioning: can type themselves, can assign someone to type or contacting a captioning service (recommended) by integrating a third party. -The host can do a breakout room and break students up into smaller groups (if using the conference feature). The host can virtually raise their hand or "go" into the group. -There is a gallery view option if you choose. -Every individual has a profile. -Attention Tracking lets you know when the student is not in the browser. You can't see what they are doing (i.e. playing a video game) but you will be alerted that they aren't in the browser. -Zoom provides online support and live trainings.	Dave Rudel
