	Winter session with no post-assessment afterward. The dates are Tue 01/08 - Fri 01/11, 2019, from 9 am – 2 pm,	
	at P218. Math Jam is designed to help students progress to transfer level math courses in a much shorter time.	
	Since most students will go into Math 13 now, Math Jam will work as a 'refresher''. Student's invest 5 hrs per day for 4 days to gain a stronger understanding of	
	fundamental mathematical concepts. Innovative math software, smaller class size, and an abundance of peer	
	tutors during Winter Math Jam help improve basic math skills quickly. Math Jam is a FREE program to help	
	students get a jump start on their spring semester math course. Participants must be Peralta Community College	
	District Students. To sign up contact Minyoung(Michelle) Lee at <u>minyounglee@peralta.edu</u> .	
	Going forward, Math Jam may turn into a prep course for Statistics.	
	In Spring/19 there will be two sections of Math 13 with support. One taught by Lawson and the other by Shah. If	
	these fill, more can be added. In fall/19 there will be 17 sections of Math 13 (9 with support and 8 without	
	support). Currently the support classes are 1 unit (30 minutes added to the class) but in the fall they will be 2	
	units (1 hour following the class). The support class is not a free standing class and students must take the support	
	class associated with the Math 13 instructor. The new courses are going through the approval process now.	

	Also, there will only be one Math 203 in the fall (to accommodate Merritt's ADN program) and no lower level Math courses. Less than one percent of STEM students have not taken intermediate algebra. If you have a student who did not take Algebra 2 in High School or a Math 203 with us, have the student take Math 13 in their first semester so that they will complete a transfer level math course in their first semester, then Math 1 in the second semester to start them in the calculus pathway. Fall 2019: only one Math 203 class will be offered to accommodate Merritt's ADN applicants. In the summer Math 202 will be offered. There will be no other non- transferable Math classes offered after Spring 2019.
