	<p>Paystub Accuracy for Sick Leave <i>Please check your paystub for sick leave accuracy. Eighty hours are given at the beginning of each year. If you are absent for a day, that equates to 8 hours, even if a full work day is 6 hours. If you are only absent part of a day, this is not the case. Funding is tracked by major. <i>See Susanna's comments above if you update the student's major.</i> -It's okay to change major on header page drop down menu to Merritt if doing an SEP for student who attends another PCCD college.</p>	Scurry
