Institution	Policy and Practices
CSU Campuses	
CSU Channel Islands	No official policy; looking to develop one
CSU Fullerton	Elective credit for completion of basic military training. It is not equated to PE or GE Area E.
	(This may change with the release of EO 1036 which encourages campuses to use
	the completion of basic military training toward satisfaction of Area E).
Cal State LA	Elective credit for completion of basic military training. It is not equated to PE or GE Area E.
	(This may change with the release of EO 1036 which encourages campuses to use
	the completion of basic military training toward satisfaction of Area E/count as a block).
CSU Long Beach	Elective credit for completion of basic military training. It is not equated to PE or GE Area E.
San Jose State	SJSU currently grants 6 units of credit for 1 year of active duty shown on the DD214 or DD295, of which 2
	units apply to the PE requirement for graduation, and 4 units apply to elective credit.
	(The current policy is being reviewed in response to EO 1036 to consider clearance of Area E)
CSU Monterey Bay	Elective credit for some courses taken as part of military training that are documented by transcripts
	(ie College of The Air Force that are not vocational and use DD 214 for Area E)
CSU Northridge	All branches except Marines receive 4 units completion of Basic Training. Marines receive 8 units
	as their Basic Training is twice the length. These are applicable to GE Section E.
Sonoma State	Elective credit for completion of basic military training. It is not equated to PE or GE Area E.
Sacramento State	Awards 4 units for Basic Training and these units clear GE Area E. We do not equate it with PE activity units.
San Diego State	Awards 2 - 8 units of elective credit depending on which branch of military served;
	it is not equated to PE or GE Area E (they do not have this area on their GE pattern)
Cal Poly Pomona	Awards 9 units of elective credit will be allowed toward a degree for a student with an honorable
	discharge who submits evidence of one year of active military service. Additional units will be
	awarded to students for other evidence of military service. It is not equated to PE or GE Area E.
CSU Dominguez Hills	Awards 6 units for basic training which completes the student's GE Area E; using the DD214 as evidence
	of active duty and that the discharge was honorable. ACE credit must be on a SMART/AARTS transcript;
	they will use some but not usually all toward elective units.
