

The Berkeley Community Gardening Collaborative has a project, **Moving South Berkeley Forward** a collaboration with U.C, Berkeley's Environmental Sciences Department. The goal of the project is to create a community garden site in South Berkeley, which will be an educational vehicle while at the same time feeding this still mostly below median income minority community.

Now that Berkeley Parks has been awarded Prop 68 state funding, and drafts of possible designs for the garden (to be located in what is to be a 4 block urban greenway) are being reviewed, it would be helpful to have someone come on board and work with me to take part in MSBF's development of this space and expansion of the student component. At the present time the gardening assistant would work 20 p/wk during the session. The summer session for gardening students is four weeks. These same students will meet on a Saturday in late August to plant seeds. The students then distribute the seedlings at Parks' annual October Harvest Festival. MSBF students also attend the Bioneers Conference.

It is most important that the person be of color mirroring the learners and community. The assistant must be both fluent with writing and speaking in Spanish.

This position is a twelve hours a week job, the exception being the 4 week summer session. The pay is \$25.00 p/h.
